Juliet Stroud Duncan



**Juliet Stroud Duncan** is an American artist working in the animation industry, and co-owner of Duncan Studio. She was born in Van Nuys, in California's San Gabriel Valley. She spent many of her formative years riding horses in the open fields of Simi Valley, living on a ranch with goats and chickens. From a young age, Juliet was drawing and sketching, sparking an interest in the arts that would carry with her as an adult. Upon graduating from Simi Valley High School, Juliet discovered the animation program at the

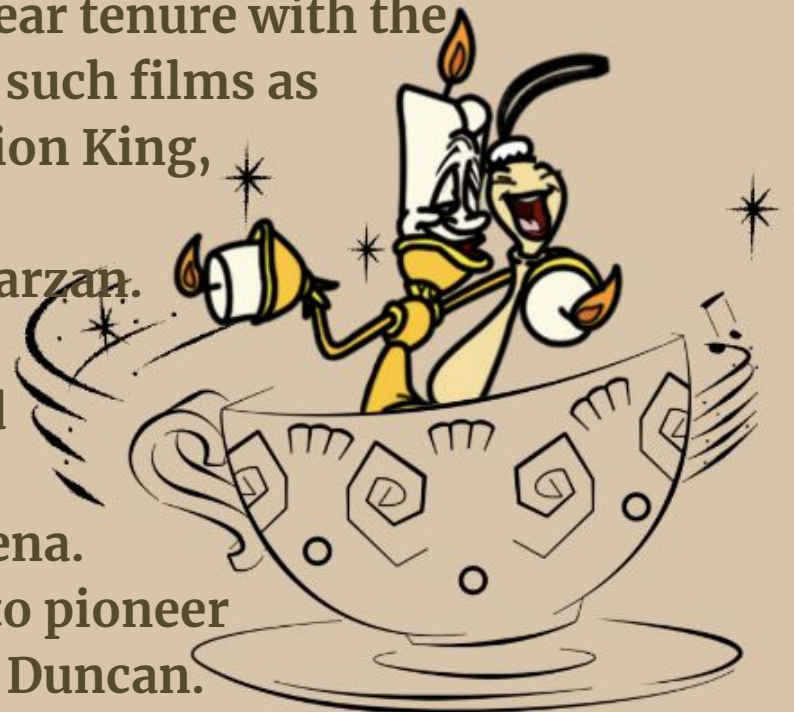
California Institute of the Arts, where she would go on to attend. In 1986, she began her career at Disney, starting as an assistant animator on the feature film **Oliver & Company**.

Over the course of her 23-year tenure with the studio, she would work on such films as **The Little Mermaid**, **The Lion King**, **Beauty and the Beast**, **Treasure Planet** and **Tarzan**.

In 1990, Juliet met Disney animator Ken Duncan. The two would eventually marry and co-found their own business in 2007: Duncan Studio in Pasadena.

After 28 years together, the two continue to pioneer independent animation with their team at Duncan.

Today, Juliet still works as an in-house artist, and recently supervised a crew of other 2D artists on **Mary Poppins Returns** for Disney.
